OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KINGHAM PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** within Kingham village, replacing the majority of the 30mph speed limit in the process, leading out to the following points:

- 1. Churchill Road a point 160 metres northeast of its junction with The Green,
- 2. <u>Station Road</u> a point 173 metres southeast of its junction with New Road,
- 3. <u>The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton/Daylesford</u> a point 15 metres north of its junction with Churchill Road/West Street.

The length of 30mph speed limit will be retained on the unnamed road north towards Chastleton/Daylesford, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account. The existing 40mph speed limits on the B4450 Station Road & Station Road also remain unaffected by these proposals.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Kingham Parish) (30m Miles Per Hour Speed Limits) Order 2021 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
