

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KINGHAM PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Kingham Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. The roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 3 to this order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Kingham Parish) (30m Miles Per Hour Speed Limits) Order 2021 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road (excluding any length of road listed in Schedules 2 & 3) in the village of Kingham extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Churchill Road	a point 160 metres northeast of its junction with The Green.

b)	Station Road	a point 173 metres southeast of its junction with New Road.
c)	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	a point 15 metres north of its junction with Churchill Road/West Street.

SCHEDULE 1 2

30mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Kingham extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Churchill Road	a point 160 metres northeast of its junction with The Green.
b)	Station Road	a point 173 metres southeast of its junction with New Road.
c)	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	a point 234 metres north of its junction with West Street.

a)	B4450 Station Road	from the centre line of Chipping Bridge, eastwards and westwards a point 52 metres northeast of the centre line of Chipping Bridge, south-westwards	for a distance of approximately 37.5 75 metres, partly in the Gloucestershire Parish of Bledington
b)	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Churchill Road/West Street, northwards	for a distance of 210 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 3

40mph Speed Limit:

a)	Station Road	from its junction with the B4450 Station Road, northwards	for a distance of 165 metres
b)	B4450 Station Road	from a point 37.5 52 metres north east of the centre line of Chipping Bridge, northeast & south-eastwards	to a point 85 metres southeast of the junction with Station Road.
