## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KINGHAM PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\*

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Kingham Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202\* and shall come into force on the day of 202\*.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
- 3. The roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
- 5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 3 to this order.
- 6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Kingham Parish) (30m Miles Per Hour Speed Limits) Order 2021 is hereby revoked.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### 20mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road (excluding any length of road listed in Schedules 2 & & 3) in the village of Kingham extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Churchill Road	a point 160 metres northeast of its junction with The	
		Green.	

b)	Station Road	a point 173 metres southeast of its junction with New Road.
c)	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	a point 15 metres north of its junction with Churchill Road/West Street.

## SCHEDULE 42

## 30mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Kingham extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

<del>a)</del>	Churchill Road	a point 160 metres northeast of its junction with The Green.
<del>b)</del>	Station Road	a point 173 metres southeast of its junction with New Road.
<del>c)</del>	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	a point 234 metres north of its junction with West Street.

a)	B4450 Station Road	from the centre line of Chipping Bridge, eastwards and westwards a point 52 metres northeast of the centre line of Chipping Bridge, south-westwards	for a distance of approximately 37.5 75 metres, partly in the Gloucestershire Parish of Bledington
b)	The unnamed road running northwards to Chastleton	from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Churchill Road/West Street, northwards	for a distance of 210 metres.

## SCHEDULE 23

#### 40mph Speed Limit:

a)	Station Road	from its junction with the B4450 Station Road, northwards	for a distance of 165 metres
b)	B4450 Station Road	from a point 37.5 52 metres northeast of the centre line of Chipping Bridge, northeast & south-eastwards	to a point 85 metres southeast of the junction with Station Road.
